RULES and REGULATIONS

The 17th International 1001 Documentary Film Festival will take place in 1-7 December 2014 in Istanbul.

The **festival** is open to documentary films of any genre, language, format and running time, provided that they were **completed after 31 December 2011**

Signed copy of Rules and Regulations, preview copies of the films and the required materials listed below should be at the festival office by **30 April 2014**. Applications received after this date or missing any of the materials listed will not be taken into consideration.

The preview copies of the films in any language other than English must be subtitled in English.

Selected films will be announced to the applicants by **15 September 2014**.

The screening format of the festival is Betacam SP, DVCAM or HDV, HD (PAL).

The screening copies of the selected films subtitled in English should be at the festival office by **30 September 2014**. The charges of all the materials sent to the festival are to be undertaken by the applicant.

Please put **“for cultural purposes only no commercial value”** remark on the envelopes sent. In order to avoid any complications please **don't write any value**.

Films submitted to the festival will be selected by a selection committee composed of documentary filmmakers, academicians studying on documentary cinema and professionals working in the documentary sector.

The festival committee has the right to designate the program and the venues.

Applicants can not withdraw their film after the festival program is announced to the public.

Applicants agree to allow the Festival committee to use maximum 3 minutes excerpts from the film or the trailer for promotional purposes.

The DVD copies of the films will not be returned and kept for the archive of the Documentary Filmmakers Association.

Applicants agree that the films in the archive can be screened in non-profit organizations, for cultural and educational purposes. In such cases the director, producer or distributor will be notified in advance.

Signed copy of Rules & Regulations [festival requires wet signature on the document, therefore it's to be sent by post] and following materials should be at the festival office by 30 April 2014.
